

Process of practice

- 1. foiling towards the camera on a beam reach course
- 2. foiling the first jibe at the camera (from toe- or heelside)
- 3. foiling away from the camera
- 4. foiling a second jibe within clearly visible range (from toe- or heelside)
- 5. foiling back to the camera
- 6. controlled stop at the camera & introduction by name at the camera
